- **Bake cookies, brownies, fudge or other treats twice in 12 months**
- **Serve as a parent's helper to look after little ones for four hours on three occasions**
- **Lead a craft workshop for six (jewelry making, scrapbooking, knitting)**
- **Direct a two hour sports clinic (soccer, basketball, track) for 10 children (age 6+)**
- **Entertain kids at a birthday party with face painting, manicures, or scavenger hunt**
- **Make specialty items like vinaigrette, jams or crafts (for cash and carry)**
- **Provide two hours of computer consultancy to teach how to use a program, manage photos, load an iPod or surf the net**
- **Tutor (if you are in high school) an elementary or middle school kid in your choice of subject**
- **Get four friends to do a group car wash for five cars (five top bidders)**
